Local Area Development Programme (LADP) is announcing Student Innovation Competition on Sustainable Energy 2017

EU-LADP has launched its sustainable energy innovation competition in Kurdistan region and invites university students to submit innovative projects that lead to less consumption of energy, reduction of CO₂ and greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions, and have beneficial economic and environmental impacts.

This is a unique opportunity for current student and/or graduated from 2014 to start their career in the field of sustainable energy.

Categories:

In order to secure fair and objective competition, 4 main categories in which projects will be competing are identified:

1. Resource conservation and/or energy efficiency
2. Transport in cities
3. Renewable energy sources
4. Smart technologies

Evaluation Procedure:

The submitted projects will be evaluated by the Sustainable Energy Innovation Committee composed of a team of experts from EU-LADP. The submitted innovation projects will be evaluated using an evaluation grid with selection criteria.

Awards:

The award-winning projects will be acknowledged with an award and presented to the general public, private sector and international donors.

Results are announced in July 2017. Two award-winning projects with best evaluation scores will be awarded in each category. First award is \$1,500 and second award is \$1,000.
